Introduction

This document is provided to the BSA collecting community as the first example of a council 'name' guide. I have listed all known BSA Councils that made a patch, neckerchief, or neckerchief slide. I have also listed the council numbers to uniquely identify organizations with the same charter name. Traditionally, most Council collecting guides place CSPs, CPs, and RWS in separate listings. Each ignored neckerchiefs and activity patches. As a collector of 'names', I want ANY exmple from each council, thus the formation of this list. I hope you enjoy it, it took 25 years of collecting to compile. The advanced collector will realize that this list is far from complete. There are approximately 150 councils listed in the Wakin's book that are not on my list. I suspect there are another 150 councils listed in the Morse book that do not have identified patches. This isn't to say these councils did not make a patch... many probably did, but I haven't found them yet. Sources such as eBay and Scout patch dealers find unlisted items on a regular basis – so please provide your input. I will gladly add a new item once I see it or a photograph of sufficient size and resolution.

My prime directive for listing a patch is inclusion of the council name, initials, and/or number on the patch. To maintain the integrity of the list, I must adhere to this rule without exception. I have seen too many examples of 'nameless' patches attributed to organizations with questionable evidence and I want to avoid unresolvable debates. Having said, that... I have encountered some level of difficulty in generating this list. The first problem occurs when only the council number appears; these may be troop issues. The second issue occurs when only the council initials appear; other organizations may have the same initials (for example, the 1929 Black Mount Camp patch only has initials and is often confused as a Blue Mountain Council issue). Also, after a council merger it is quite common for the old names to be used as district names. There are several cases where badges made by these districts appear to be issues of the former council. Mid Columbia District of Columbia Pacific Council is one such example. Finally, patches quite often list the council name different than listed on the charter, which means that erroneous names may appear on checklists. The "Cochise Council" RWS issue from Cochise County Council is an example.

Incorrect council names & "AREA"

The council name appearing on a patch should never be taken as the official charter name because they are quite often incomplete or incorrect. For example, patches from Milwaukee County Council omit the word 'County'. In a similar manner many councils were chartered with the word "AREA" in their name, but left this word off the patch. Examples are issues from Mount Baker Area, Tumwater Area, Cascade Area, etc. The opposite is also true. Some councils were never chartered with the word "AREA" in their name, yet they issued patches including this word. Oregon Trail and Crater Lake Councils are examples. Furthermore, the BSA annual reports often leave out the word 'Area' when listing councils leading to conflicting information as to the official council name. Since many council listings were derived from these reports, many collector listings are in error. My literature review from the key researchers (Morse,

Hoogeveen, Breithaupt, Watkins) quite often conflict each other when the word 'Area' appears in a council name. For this reason, I defer to the Morse book, which I believe is the most accurate unless I am able to locate better a better source. The key outcome of this information is that I only list councils under the chartered name, not by the name appearing on the patch. To be clear, when a council name exists with and without the word 'Area', I list both cases only if charter information has been identified for both cases.

Foot-Notes:

- The patch has been reported by a collector, but the author has not received the badge or photograph to confirm existence.
- The Chocktaw RWS attributed to 477 may have been issued by 302, 477, or both
- The Dan Beard RWS' attributed to 529 may have been issued by 529, 438, or both
- The Erie County KRHS was used by 376. It may have also been issued by 511.
- No records or documentation have been identified to confirm this council was chartered by the BSA. However, patches exist with the indicated name. It is possible that the name was abbreviated to fit on the patch. In some cases, the patch may be foreign or a Girl Scout issue.
- There is no known charter for New Mexico Council. However, there are charters for Northern New Mexico and Eastern New Mexico councils. Since RWS and RWHS exist for Northern New Mexico Council, these patches were likely issued by Eastern New Mexico.
- The Sunrise Council RWS was issued by National Supply for official BSA training events. It was never a chartered council.
- The Old Colony RWS attributed to 247 may have been issued by 249, 247, or both.
- The Piedmont Area RWS attributed to 594 may have been issued by 042, 594, 420 or all.
- The Pioneer Trails RWS attributed to 500 may have been issued by 155, 500, or both.
- The Wolverine RWS attributed to 711 may have been issued by 255, 711, or both.
- Possible district patch or community strip
- Patches from these councils are suspected fakes
- This patch was issued by national supply as an example of new insignia to replace RWS. No council was chartered under this name.
- Issued by Mount Baker Area #603 in 1990
- Issued by Two Rivers #127 in 1991
- Issued by Utah National Parks Council #591
- Issued by Western LA County #057 in 1988 for the movie "The Wrong Guys". Fictitious council name, but the BSA actually assigned a council number!
- "Hills Council" appears on a 1958 Camp Hamilton patch. I believe this is an error as the 1955/6 Camp Hamilton patch indicates "Hoosier Hills Council"
- Issued by the Western Los Angeles County Council. This CSP was used in the movie "The Wrong Guys"

Key: Explanation

This guide provides a small check box next to each council name. To help assist the collector locate the badge. I tried to apply some level of logic by having the box shape indicate the kind of badge that is available. Here is my logic:

*Most collectors want a CSP from each council name
If a CSP was not made, they will want a JSP
If a CSP or JSP was not made, they will want a RWS type
If CSP, JSP, RWS types are not made, they will take a CP
If none of these are available, they will take an activity patch
If no patches were made, they will take a neckerchief or slide*

The check-boxes identified in the key apply the above logic with the priority in the sequence defined above. That is, if a council made a CSP, then () is used even if a JSP, RWS, CP, etc. was made. [] is used if no CSP or JSP was made, but a RWS type was made - even if CPs and activity issues were made. Etc. Etc.

Definitions

AP – 'Activity Patch.' A patch bearing a council name, numbers, and/or initials along with additional information such as date, event name, camp name, OA name, etc.

CP – 'council patch' made for the sole purpose of identifying a council. An example is shown in figure #1. These are odd shape patches, often round, square, triangular, etc that indicate the name, initials, and/or council number. This kind of patch does not include any additional text other than lettering to identify the council location. It does not indicate an event, slogan, anniversary, etc. CPs were generally worn on the right uniform pocket or on neckerchiefs.

CSP – 'Council Shoulder Patch.' A multicolored 'standard shape' patch featuring a custom embroidered design. It was worn on the left uniform shoulder. An example is pictured in figure #2.

JSP – This is essentially a CSP, but the lettering or design features information indicating the patch was issued for a jamboree.

KRHS – This is a shoulder arc (aka 'Half Strip') featuring the council name in red lettering on khaki colored cloth and a red edge. See figure #4 for an example in the red/white style. These patches were worn on the left uniform shoulder and used from 1929 through 1953. The khaki base material ranges from tan to green. Tan colored cloth was used in the 1930's and early 1940's where the khaki-green patches are generally post WWII issues. In some cases, fine tan twill (aka 'sand twill') was used during the WW2 era.

KRS – This is a shoulder strip featuring the council name in red lettering on khaki colored cloth and a red edge. Figure #3 provides an example with red/white color combination. These patches were worn on the left uniform shoulder and used from the early 1930's through 1953. The khaki base material ranges from tan to green. Tan colored cloth was used in the 1930's and early 1940's where the khaki-green patches are generally post WWII issues.

Neckerchief Slide: A device used to secure neckerchief ends around the neck of the wearer. Generally made of plastic, metal or leather. Also known as a woggle.

RWHS – This is a shoulder arc featuring the council name in white lettering on red colored cloth and a white edge. See Figure #4. These patches were worn on the left uniform shoulder and used from 1953 through the mid 1970's when they were replaced by CSPs.

RWS – This is a shoulder strip featuring the council name in white lettering on red colored cloth and a white edge. See figure #3. These patches were worn on the left uniform shoulder and used from 1953 through the mid 1970's when they were replaced by CSPs.
